Rev. Johnson is a graduate of Union College in Kentucky and has served on their Board of Trustees and received a graduate degree from the Boston University School of Theology where he served on the Alumni Board.

## P R O F E S S I O N A L P R O F I L E

Reverend Jack Johnson is an ordained United Methodist pastor and has served in church, civic, and governmental settings throughout his fifty-year career in ministry.

He has served as Executive Director of the Massachusetts Council of Churches an ecumenical body whose members include some 1700 congregations throughout the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Jack has worked with the Harvard Divinity Pluralism Project, the Boston Theological Institute, and the Harvard Kennedy School. Rev. Johnson's civic and government engagement included serving as Mayor of Toms River, N.J. Chairing Legislative Commissions for the state of New Jersey, and served in advisory capacities to Governors Kean, Florio, McGreevy, and Corzine as well as serving on Municipal and County Advisory Boards in Ocean, Monmouth, and Mercer Counties. Presently he serves on the Martin Luther King Commission for the state of New Jersey and the Ambassadors Re-Entry Program.

Rev. Johnson has co-founded Contact Teleministries of Ocean County, the Coalition for Peace Action in Princeton, Interfaith Neighbors of Monmouth County and was the founder of Cease Fire New Jersey whose organization promoted our nation's first assault weapon ban as well as establishing the nation's first smart gun law. Cease Fire New Jersey awarded Rev. Johnson their Lifetime Achievement Award.
