The Reverend Jeanne Radak serves as the Presbytery Leader of the Highlands that includes eighty-one Presbyterian Congregations in Hunterdon, Morris, Somerset, Sussex, Warren, and Passaic Counties.

In 1985 Rev. Radak was ordained in the First Presbyterian Church of Geneva, New York. She has served as interim pastor for congregations in New York, Indiana and Michigan and pastored the Elmwood Presbyterian Church in Syracuse New York until 2005 at which time she became Associate Director for Congregational Ministry of Philadelphia.

Reverend Radak became the Presbytery Leader of Newton in 2013 which in March of 2021 the Newton Presbytery realigned its boundaries to become the Highlands Presbytery.

Rev Radak has extensive engagement in leadership roles including conflict management, Interim Ministries, congregational transformation, urban ministries, leading change, and focus on missionary church initiatives.
